Live From the Formosa Tea House, Session Four

We recorded **Live From the Formosa Tea House: Episode 4** this afternoon over lunch. At the [Formosa Tea House](#). Live.

We recorded in the coveted back room of the Formosa, with a very simple technical setup. We all sat around [Dan James' APEX435 microphone](#), which ran into [Steven Garrity's Behringer Eurotrack UB802 mixer](#). We took the output of the mixer and plugged it into my [iMic](#), which was plugged into a USB port on my [laptop](#). I did the recording in [Sound Studio](#), saved as an AIFF file, then imported the file into iTunes and converted to an MP3 (24 kbps mono, VBR medium quality).

This episode runs one and a half hours. It didn't feel "too long" when we were recording it, so we've decided to release it completely unedited to maintain the "three guys having lunch" feel. It *may* feel too long to listen to. Things we discuss:

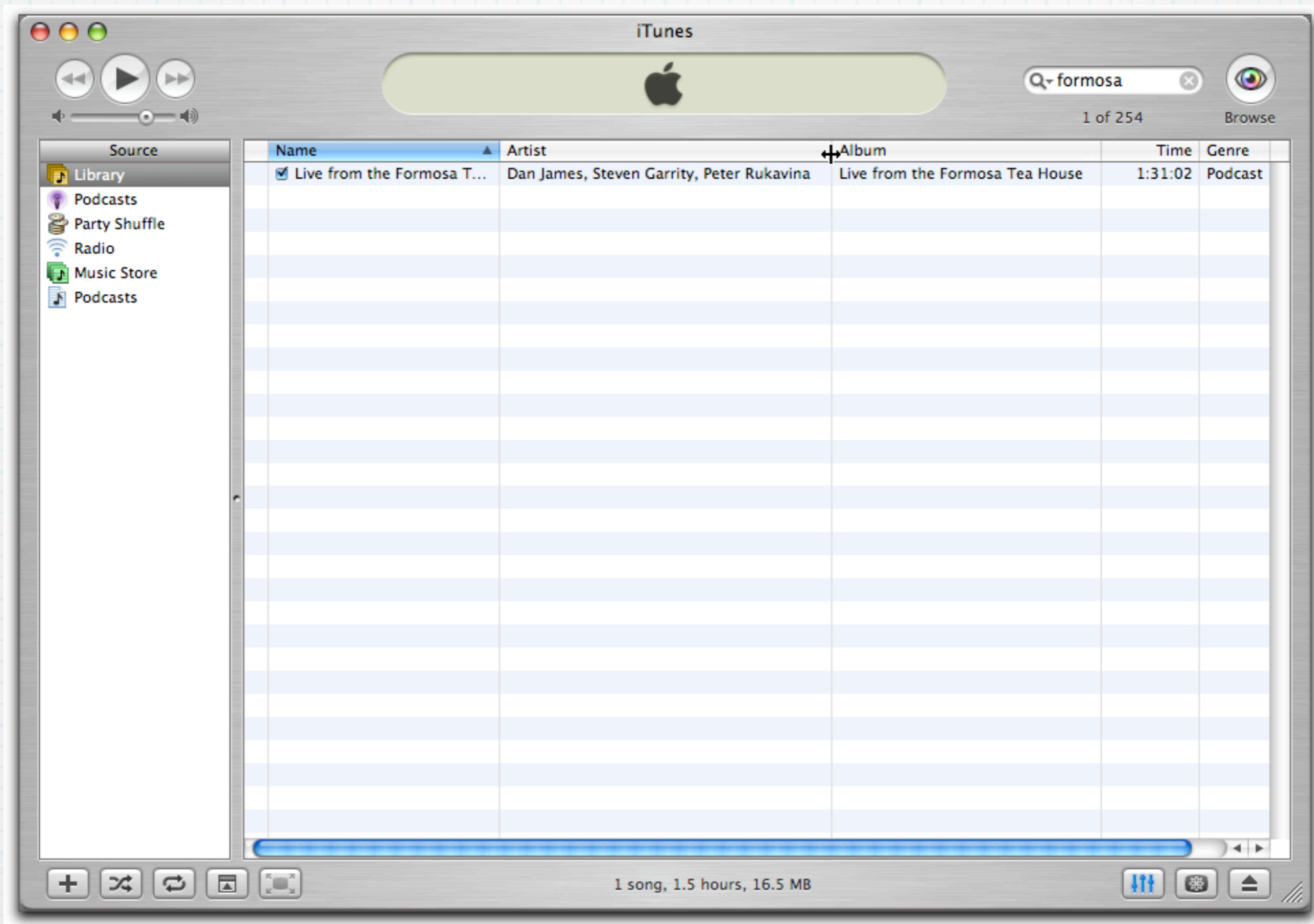

The New New Things

The oven timer just dinged and some of the things we've been cooking up in Flickr HQ are ready for serving. If you want to dive right in, check out the new [explore page](#) and skip the rest of this post ;)

- First up is **clustering**, a better way to explore photos through tags. You can still see the most recent photos with a given tag (say, [summer](#)) but now you can also root around the finer distinctions: [summer beach vacations](#) versus [summer flowers and nature](#) - and all the clusters are [collected on one page](#). It's neat!
- Here are some good tags to try: [lion](#), [cute](#), [graduation](#), [europe](#) or even one of the classic search disambiguation problems like [jaguar](#) or [turkey](#) - nicely broken up into [the country](#), [the food](#) and [the thanksgiving favorite](#).
- The other new feature is called **interestingness** and it's huge! A long time in the making, interestingness is a ranking algorithm based on user behavior around the photos taking into account some obvious things like how many users add the photo to their favorites and some subtle things like the relationship between the person who uploaded the photo and the people who are commenting (plus a whole bunch of secret sauce).



It's huge because we have hundreds of thousands of photos uploaded every day - now we have a way to find the good ones: here are [some of the best from December 11th, 2004](#) or check out this [monthly calendar view of March 2005](#). There's

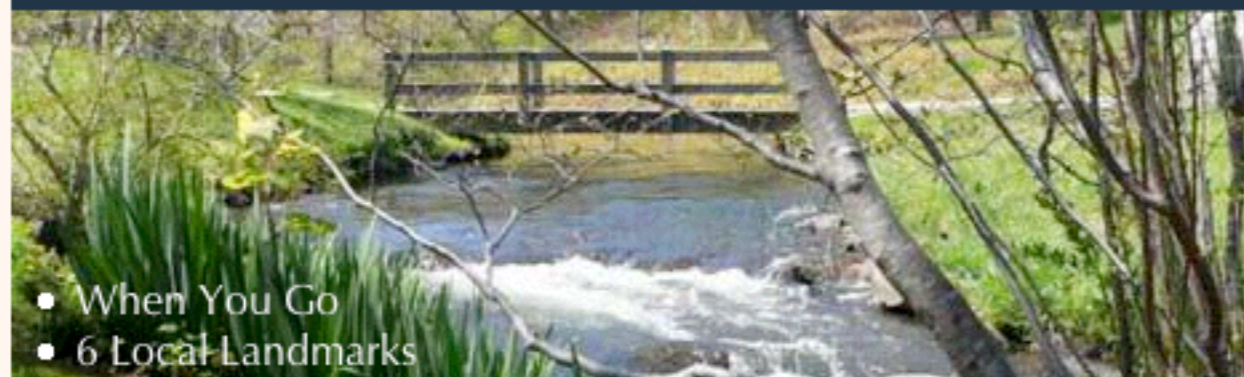
